- Ensure all design information produced is issued to relevant internal/ external departments within correct timeframes
- Co-ordinate all legal aspects in relation to various agreements i.e Section 28 and arrange bonds, guarantees, warranties and insurances as required
- Identify the need for external consultants – agreeing fees, the scope of service, timescales and deliverability
- Control the submission of building regulations and warranty applications
- Produce detailed design programme which identifies key dates and a critical path
- Support, manage and develop the internal design team
- Carrying out technical reviews
- Coordinate / obtain planning and building control approvals and discharging conditions
