As Group HS&E Manager you will be responsible for providing a comprehensive health and safety service across the business to ensure the company remains compliant with all relevant legislation. You will be responsible for the Health & Safety Team.

In this role, you will be responsible to the Group Managing Director.

- Maintaining all health and safety policies and updating as required ensuring the company is proactively aware of any changes to health & safety legislation
- Providing clear and concise reports, procedures and guidance documents
- Lead operational and management teams in identifying any areas of concern and opportunities for continuous improvement
- Provide professional support and advice to all staff on Safety, Health, Environmental and Quality matters.
- Be responsible for retaining and the renewal of our QEMS accreditations such as ISO 9001, 14001 and 45001 as well as maintaining other accreditations such as: CHAS, Constructionline, SafeContractor etc
- Assist staff and contractors in respect of compliance with relevant legislation, client standards and contractual arrangements.
- Provide support in developing, reviewing and monitoring of the HSEQ Plan and objectives and targets.
- Provide positive leadership and promote the adoption of best practice.
- Drive the philosophy of safety ownership throughout all levels of the organisation
- Be the point of contact for the HSE & Environmental Agency
- Participate and deliver health & safety campaigns, initiatives & training including a monthly bulletin



Continuous improvements

You will contribute to the overall running and continuous improvement of the business, along with the development of Meldrum Group, by ensuring that the highest professional standards are maintained to continually improve the service given to Clients. This includes:

General requirements

Once inducted, you should demonstrate a clear understanding of the Company's structure, values and procedures, including the QEMS. In relation to this, you must advise your line manager immediately of any visits to site by external agencies such as the Health & Safety Executive, Environmental Health Officers etc.
